Hosanna, *hoshi'a na* in Hebrew, is first cried out in Psalm 118:25 as a pleading, “Save, please!” followed immediately by, “Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord.” (Psalm 118:26, emphasis added), the cry answered almost before it was uttered. Over time, because of His faithfulness, *hoshi'a na* came to mean, “Praise God, His Salvation is coming!”
