APRIL FOOL'S DAY

The origins of April Fools' Day, also known as All Fools' Day, are uncertain. Some historians believe the holiday began in ancient Rome with the festival of Hilaria, a day of rejoicing and play-acting in honor of Cybele, thought to be the mother of the gods. Others believe it originated in the Middle Ages, when the new year was celebrated on April 1st instead of January 1st. When the calendar was changed to begin the year on January 1st, people who continued to celebrate the new year on April 1st were referred to as "fools" and were the targets of pranks and jokes. Still, others believe that it is a remnant of a pagan festival, such as the festival of the vernal equinox, which is celebrated around the same time. Whatever its origin, April Fools' Day has become a day for playing practical jokes and hoaxes on one another.
